THE CITY

Pescara is the most populous city of the Abruzzo region with 123,245 inhabitants although the urban area, however, extends well beyond the territorial limits of the municipality and includes several neighboring towns thus adding approximately 330,000 inhabitants.

It is here, with L'Aquila, the offices of the Board, the Executive and the Regional Department and is also home together with Gabriele d'Annunzio University in Chieti, which houses the school of architecture, economics, foreign languages and literature and of managerial sciences. It has also an important tourist port, the port of Pescara and the Abruzzo International Airport. The Port

of Pescara with 1,250 berths with state of the art services and facilities shipbuilding and plays an important role in the Adriatic Sea, especially for connections with Croatia.

Until 1927 the current municipal area was divided between two areas: Pescara, south of the river of the same name, in the province of Chieti, and Castellammare Adriatico, north of the river, in the province of Teramo. Following the unification of the two centers, in 1927, was also set up the province, thanks to the efforts of Gabriele d'Annunzio and James unripe.

After World War II, Pescara has had a significant economic and demographic development.

It has known since the twenties and thirties of the twentieth century, an intense influx of immigrants, mostly from other parts of the Abruzzi, and, to a lesser extent, from other Italian regions. Immigration, after a lull due to the Second World War and resumed strongly in the second half of the forties, and lasted to the present day. The composition of immigration is, however, changed considerably since the eighties of the last century. In the city there are so come to form, over time, colonies of Albanians, Chinese, Romanians, Ukrainians. In total, there were, in December 2010, about 6,183 foreign residents in the municipality, approximately 5% of the total population. To these must be

added an unquantifiable number of immigrants in the territory in an irregular situation.

Today Pescara is a city with a predominantly modern, which has preserved few traces of its past in part because of heavy bombing during the Second World War and previous destruction throughout history.

The main artery of the city is now composed of Corso Umberto I, which combines Corso Vittorio Emanuele II at Promenade (First of May Square) and laterally across the square Rebirth, better known as Piazza Lounge. The palaces of the Province and the Municipality are located in Italian piazza, near the river, while the one used by the regional council is in Union Square, overlooking Manthonè course, the course of the old Pescara, which is now the center of the nightlife.

Pescara annually hosts major musical events (Pescara Jazz) and film (Flaiano Award) from the seventies that enliven the cultural life of the city during the summer.

Traditional holidays

The traditional **Saint Andrew's Holiday** (festa di Sant'Andrea) takes place every year in July with a characteristic (typical) sea parade (seamen parade), dating back to 1867, in the area of the marine village near the port, as devotion of the sailors to their patron saint.

The **Madonna dei Sette dolori Holiday**, instead, takes place every year, on the first Sunday of June at the Madonna dei sette dolori sanctuary, following a very ancient tradition.

The Gonfaloni regatta (boat-race) takes place every year in July, since 1994: it's a race among 8 metres long boats, and 10 rowers facing each other on the Aterno-Pescara river. Every boat stands for other navy/marine realities of the Adriatic Sea or of other Mediterranean places. On October 10, we celebrate the city's patron saint, **San Cetto**.




kitchen

You can define the kitchen of Abruzzo as a set of different tastes, which is structured around a number of typical main dishes. A land of great agricultural and pastoral tradition, Abruzzo offers a wide range of aromas and flavors.

For the **first dishes** excel **maccheroni alla chitarra**, a dough pulled into sheets and cut with the "guitar", a traditional tool consisting of a beech frame having at the top strings tight and parallel on which to press the pastry with a rolling pin: so you create the typical maccheroni alla chitarra square profile and excellent with the many sauces typical of Abruzzo. Yet there are among the first maccheroni alla mugnaia and cannelloni all'abruzzese, slices of puff pastry rolled and stuffed with mixed meat (chicken, beef, pork). For the toppings are **highlighted all'abruzzese** sauce, mutton sauce, sausage sauce, duck sauce. These are flanked by "pasta and beans", bean soup with noodles rustic water and flour, served with soupy sauce of fresh tomatoes, garlic, olive oil and hot pepper. Among the zonal kitchens, the remarkable "gnocchi carats" Aquila, topped with bacon, eggs and cheese. Teramo emerge from the "scrippelle", "crepes" served "m'busse" (wet, that is in stock) or used to build pies, topped with meat sauce or meatballs with gravy, boiled eggs and fresh pecorino. **The virtues** are an ancient recipe of fresh and dried pasta, legumes and vegetables that the custom is to be consumed at the beginning of May. They make worthy crown ravioli stuffed with ricotta cheese with sugar and cinnamon, topped with a thick sauce of pork; the "pastuccia" stew, polenta with sausage, egg and grated pecorino cheese.

In the **second dishes** excel lamb in the mountain areas and fish in the sea areas. The roast lamb, rustic and tasty dish base, has variations in the "kebabs" skewers with pieces of mutton cooked in embers alive; cotturo lamb stew with mountain herbs in copper cauldron of the shepherds; Finally lamb with cheese and egg, dish of lamb stew, scrambled eggs, cheese and lemon zest. Finally note the aspic or turkey alla canzanese Teramo area, cold dishes with gelatine derived from the same food.

The fish is cooked Adriatic varied in the three "soups" base, three variants with epicenters Giulianova, Pescara and Vasto, cooked



in a crock with fresh tomatoes and various herbs, with the final touch of hot pepper.

Another chapter is inevitable that the rustic pizzas, pizza by Easter (a rustic cake with cheese and pepper Teramo area), the fiadoni from Chieti, mixture of eggs / cheese nicely puffed, baked in a thin sheet of dough tied in a handkerchief, the ubiquitous rustic tarts, a pastry case filled with salted eggs, sausages, cheeses, cottage cheese, vegetables, herbs and spices.

And what about meats and cheeses? You don't have to miss the sausages for spreading from Teramo fragrant nutmeg, **liver sausages with garlic** and spicy, or the admirable **ventricina** from Vasto, large pieces of fat and lean meat from the shoulder and ham, pressed and matured with sweet pepper powder and hints of fennel and red pepper, mountain air, dried pig's stomach itself? O **pecorino and mozzarella** that dot the valleys and hills, from the famous Atri and Rivisondoli, the myriad, fresh or expertly seasoned.

Desserts from Abruzzo are famous in the world: those unfamiliar with the confetti of Sulmona firm William Di Carlo and Confetti Pelino? And the soft chocolate nougat Nurzia Aquila, so often imitated in vain? And the **Parrozzo** confectionery company Luigi D'Amico of Pescara, baptized by D'Annunzio, superb dough with almonds, flour, eggs, sugar and flavoring of bitter almonds? But these masterpieces of haute patisserie alongside the traditional sweets, often surprising, always delicious: **ferratelle**, anise pods cooked in a red-hot pliers jaws wide-grooved, **cicerchiata**, balls of fried dough with honey baked donut-related, the crisp, kind of nougat with almonds and caramelized sugar, flavored with lemon, mostaccioli, hearty cookies sweetened with cooked grape must; and then the pepatelli Teramo, biscuits bran, almonds and honey well peppered; and yet, from Guardiagrele the macaroons and the **side of the nuns**, three-cornered hats of sponge cake with cream, and finally by Lanciano **bocconotti** cakes pastry with the filling of cooked almonds and chocolate.

MOVING TO ITALY



EU citizens:

To enter: for a period less than 3 months is required only proof of identity. For citizens belonging to a member state of the European Union who intend to stay in the country for a period longer than three months is sufficient to require the certificate of birth registration issued by the municipality where they live (must subscribe to the municipality of residence).

Non-EU citizens:

To enter: it is necessary to present your passport and, where required, a visa.

Foreigners who come to Italy for visits, business, tourism and study for periods not exceeding three months, need not apply for a residence permit. Instead, whoever wants to come to live in Italy for work, to attend a course of study or vocational training and those who want to be reunited with a family member, such as the husband, wife or a child who is already living in Italy, you must request residence permit within 8 days of the regular arrival in Italy.

It can also living in Italy who requests the status of refugee, who requires special medical treatment or those who come to our country for religious reasons: in all these cases, the alien is issued a residence permit.

Depending on the reason for which it is to live in Italy, the request for a residence permit must be submitted to the Single Desk for Immigration, which is located near all the prefectures Italian, or the Chief of Police or the Post Office. To the City and the Patronato you can find help and support.

Since 2009, Italy has been introduced in l' "integration agreement" that the alien must take out at the time of application for a residence permit for not less than one year. The foreigner will have two years, during which the Italian state will support him in the path of integration, including through the provision of public education, which will provide appropriate courses of Italian language.

All types of residence permits are issued by the Police. Faking a residence permit or use a fake is a serious crime.

The alien may enter Italy for reasons of employment and obtain the relevant permit, only if it has received an offer from an employer regularly resident in Italy. The employer must submit to the Single Desk for Immigration (for address and times vd. Chap. 8 on the Services) to request a "without prejudice" to the recruitment of foreign workers. If the employer gets the "cleared" by the OSS, the Italian Embassy or Consulate issue a visa to the foreigner in Italy for reasons of employment.

The residence permit issued for the purposes of study or vocational training can last up to one year; one issued for self-employ-

ment up to two years and one for family reunification has the same duration of the residence permit of the alien family member already living in Italy.

Residence permits will last, at most, two years and, if permitted by law, may be renewed for the same reasons for which they were first released. The renewal application must be submitted within 60 days from the date of expiry. The residence permit for seasonal work and can not be renewed upon its expiry, the employee must return to the country of origin. This permit can be converted into a residence permit for reasons of employment, when in accordance with certain conditions.

If the police does not grant or revoke (ie removes) a residence permit, the alien, if you plan to be in good standing may apply to the court which will verify his right.

The alien who, for at least five years of a residence permit valid, which proves to have sufficient income to maintain and suitable housing can get the "residence permit for EC long-term residents," for themselves and their families. To request it, with certain exceptions, must pass a test (ie a test) knowledge of the Italian language. This permit is for an indefinite period.

WORKING IN ITALY



To find a job in Italy you can subscribe to the **Job Centre** nearest to the place where you intend to stay.

To **subscribe** an Italian or foreign citizen must meet the **following requirements**:

- be at least 16 years of age and have completed their compulsory education ie having attended school for a total duration of 10 years or, alternatively, at least be 18 years of age.
- be domiciled in the same geographical area where the Employment Center is located.

Documents to be submitted for registration are:

- Tax Code
- identification document (identity card or passport)
- Living document valid or receipt of the first issue of a residence permit for work.

Access to employment

The **non-EU citizen** can work if:

- 1 has a residence permit for an indefinite period (art. 9 TUDLgs. 286/98);
- 2 has a valid residence permit for:
 - Self-employment, Dependent, Hold jobs
 - Asylum (granted to those who already have the recognition of the status of political refugee)
 - Humanitarian Reasons (is released at the time of renewal of a residence permit for subsidiary protection)
 - Reasons for overtime
 - Study and Training (you can work with a number of hours up to 20 hours per week or for a maximum of 1040 hours per year)
 - Family (family reasons-reunification / family cohesion), Support the child.
 - Reliance
 - Subsidiary protection (Art.23 paragraph 2 of Legislative Decree 251/07). The holders of the status of political refugee status and subsidiary protection enjoy the same treatment granted to the Italian citizen for the job, subordinate and autonomous for enrollment in professional, vocational training and internship in the workplace (Art.25 of Legislative Decree 251/07)
 - Social protection: you also accept the receipt as motivation itself is indicated by the Police itself.
- 3 has the receipt:
 - di first issue of a residence permit for employment is waiting to residence permit having lost his job with which he entered in Italy;
 - di family reunification.

EU citizens

A foreign national community can work and take advantage of the various services available from Job Centres if they have:

1. Proof of identity (valid); 2. Tax Code

GO TO SCHOOL



School registration for the foreigner

The right to education is guaranteed to the foreign **citizen legally residing** in Italy in the same conditions as Italian citizens. The **foreign minors** present on Italian territory have the right to education regardless of the regularity of the location of their residence, in the form and manner prescribed for Italian citizens.

Compulsory education, integrated in the concept of right-duty to education and training (as is also required by 53/03 L.) are affected by minors who have between 15 and 18 years regardless of the regularity of the position in order to living in Italy for much-even for these pupils school enrollment can occur at any time of the school year.

However, the enrollment of the child illegally present in Italy in no way implies the regularization of the residence or the child nor the parent.

The enrollment of the student in a foreign school classes can occur at any time of the year and then even when the school year began.

When the foreign minor is devoid of the record of ages, one of the parents or the person responsible for the child declares under its own responsibility, the personal data of the child. In this case, the school enrollment is made subject but this does not affect the achievement and the issuing of the final courses of study.

Vaccinations

The enrollment of foreign children must be upheld even in the absence of health certification concerning vaccinations carried out. The document certifying the mandatory vaccinations carried out by the pupil also foreign to their country of origin must be translated into Italian. When the child does not have one, the school will proceed anyway enrollment advising, however, the local health jurisdiction.

The cultural mediator

To make the right to education and to promote the integration of foreign children, the law provides that the State, the regions and local authorities to take steps to promote and support initiatives for the reception, the inclusion in the Italian social context but to the protection of the culture and language of origin.

The faculty formulates proposals for the allocation of foreign students in the classes preferring the presence of more foreign students from the same country so as to facilitate the work of cultural mediators in the teaching of Italian language and culture learning in their activities the country of origin of the students.

Right to education for adults

The right to education is also granted to foreign adults. A first requirement for many foreigners is to learn the Italian language. To this end, many educational centers activated literacy classes that usually are organized on different levels (basic, intermediate, advanced). Of course, the foreigner will be placed at the level that corresponds to the degree of knowledge of the Italian language after a preliminary test. In this way they can achieve precisely the **elementary school**. The foreign adults who wish to obtain the **license media** in Italy, must apply for admission to the headmaster of the school specifying their anagraphical data, their studies and the job position. In these cases, a good knowledge of the Italian language and the possession of a valid residence permit.

In general the implementation of the project for continuing education of adults has been given to the **Permanent Territorial Centres** for Adult Education (CTP) that are distributed throughout the national territory and their function is to accommodate the demand for education and training of adults. UNIVERSITY



Foreign students in Italy

Article 39 of the Consolidated Law on Immigration provides access to Italian university to foreigners legally residing in Italy at the same conditions as Italian citizens. You need to have studied a whole 10 years. the responsibility to assess the suitability of the securities for registration Lies with the individual universities. The application form is presented directly at the chosen faculty with all documentation attached, a list of which is available on the website of the **Ministry of Foreign Affairs (www.esteri. It)**.

The 'bureaucratic

Here's what a student residing abroad intending to study in Italy has to prepare.

In the first place you should contact the Italian embassy in your country for issuing **visas for study**. The number of visas granted is determined by the availability of seats of the universities. By December 31 of each year, each university will provide the number of places reserved for foreigners to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

The economic requirements

Access to university is permitted only to those who show the availability of sufficient means of subsistence for the duration of stay and for the return to their country of origin. It's necessary to have more than **350 euro per month for the duration of the residence permit**. Since the visa usually lasts for one year, the student must demonstrate that they have access to about 4500 euro. For those who do not have that disposable income there is the possibility of receiving financial guarantees by Italian authorities, registered as the Presidency of the Council, which in their statutes provide for the granting of scholarships.

Once in Italy, the student has the obligation to request, within eight days of their entry, residence permit that will accompany him only for the first phase of enrollment in the chosen faculty and is normally valid until December.

For the purposes of registration, the student must, first of all, successfully pass the **Italian language test** that takes place at every faculty the first few days of September. To enroll in a limited number of faculties (eg. Faculty of Medicine), the student must also pass a test access.

Benefits and scholarships

The Immigration Act provides for equality of treatment between Italian and foreign students on contributions in support of the student. These contributions consist in assignment of scholarships, accommodation places or contributions on rent, meal vouchers etc.

Equivalence of certificates and diplomas

Academic qualifications obtained abroad have no legal value in Italy (art.170 of the RD n.1592 / 1933). Articles. 170 and 332 of the same decree provides for holders of foreign academic qualifications the opportunity to ask their equivalence with the corresponding Italian titles.

By virtue of the autonomy granted to universities, the academic authorities are given the power to assess whether the qualifications obtained abroad may have correspondence in our higher education system.

The **application should** be addressed to the **RECTOR of a university** in whose statute there's a course of study comparable with the one completed abroad.

Recognition of qualifications

Every European country has a national information center on the recognition of qualifications obtained abroad. Anyone interested in seeing their titles recognized abroad may apply directly to the Information Centre in the country in which one intends to relocate for work or study.

The academy is an institution of the State of Higher Education in Art and Music. The training is organized in academic subject areas that coordinate all sectors artistic disciplines as defined by the relevant Ministerial Decrees. HEALTH CARE

The Ministry of Health summed up **in ten rules** health care to foreigners:

1. All **non-EU foreigners** present in Italy with a **regular residence permit** are obliged to enroll in the National Health Service;
2. By registering you will acquire the same rights and duties of assistance granted to Italian citizens;
3. The assistance is also guaranteed to **dependents** residing legally
4. The registration takes place at the local health residence or stay (as indicated on the permit) and valid until the expiry of the permit. To register are sufficient for a residence permit, social security number and proof of residence (replaceable, if the alien is not a resident, with a written statement of habitual residence). If an alien who has the obligation / right has not yet formalized its entry, this should not lead in any way to assist the impossibility: indeed, in this case, the entry will be retired. To maintain registration, the expiry of the residence permit, it is sufficient that the alien exhibit anagrafe health docket of the renewal request issued by the Police.
5. **foreign students and au pairs**, and those with a residence permit for other reasons (eg. Choice of residence, religious reasons, etc..) Have two options: either take out a private insurance policy due in Italy against the risk of disease and injury and for the protection of motherhood, or voluntarily enroll in the National Health Service by paying a fixed annual fee varies according to the type of permit. With the voluntary registration may be assisted also any dependent children by paediatricians, renewable annually.
6. If foreigners have instead a **short-term residence permit** must have private insurance, or otherwise pay full price for care and services received
7. Even the irregular (**ie no permit to stay**) are insured at public and private accredited ambulatory care and hospital essentials (ie medical care, diagnostic and treatment related pathologies that are not immediately dangerous, but that could increase the damage to health and risk to life) for those urgent illness and injury, and those of preventive medicine. They are guaranteed in particular:
 - The protection of pregnancy and maternity, as well as the health of the child
 - Vaccinations and prophylaxis interventions international
 - The prevention, diagnosis and treatment of infectious diseasesThe provision of these services is linked to a **card / code "STP"** (Temporarily Present Foreigner) releasable by the Medical
8. In the case of **destitute foreigners**, the performance of the previously mentioned are insured without incurring any charges. The hardship must be declared by filling out a form that is attached to the Ministerial Circular no. 5/2000
9. The law prohibits health care facilities to report to the police the presence of irregular (except in cases where it is mandatory

for patients Italian)

10. Who wants to **come to Italy to be taken care** of before must have an entry visa and a residence permit for medical treatment. To achieve this it is necessary that you meet a series of requirements and requirements imposed by law - administrative (payment to the same structure as a security deposit equal to 30% of the total estimated cost of the required performance) and social (documentation confirming the availability of accommodation and meals outside the health care facility and return to clients and for the accompanying person)

LEARN ITALIAN LANGUAGE

In the event that a foreign citizen or immigrant community is planning to move to Italy, the advice is to attend a language course that covers the six reference levels in which the **Common European Framework of Languages** is divided (**A1, A2, B1, B2, C1 and C2**) and that it is able to equip the students with linguistic tools aimed at improving their capacity for learning and academic success, and to encourage the acquisition of certifications have an official attestation of knowledge of Italian language.

The national school system (**Permanent Territorial Centres for Education and Training in Age Adult - CTP**) and private social associations offer various possibilities for foreign people living in Italy to attend free courses of Italian language learning. The Permanent Territorial Centres for Education and Training in Adult Age are public institutions, where they work alongside teachers in the school of the State, as required by figures of experts and external collaborations, to provide cultural activities, education and training for adults.

The courses of the Italian Permanent Territorial Centres (CTP) also include elements of civic education that is related to the rights and duties of citizens. They can enroll in a course of CTP **all foreign citizens who have reached 16 years of age**. At the end of the course you can get the certificate of proficiency in the Italian language.

You can get the certification of knowledge of the Italian language also by attending a free course of Italian language for foreigners at an association or private schools, the addresses are found both in the **Yellow Pages** and on the **Internet**. However, the Italian courses offered by **private schools** are generally more expensive than those offered by popular schools or other public institutions. The height difference between the prices of the courses offered by the various institutions is not necessarily indicative of the quality of supply. In search of the ideal course you should pay attention to both the expected number of teaching hours is the number of participants expected: it is possible that learning is most effective when the number of participants is limited.

An alternative method, or additional, to learn Italian is one of the **online courses**, which are very numerous.

Knowledge of Italian, and permission for EC long-term residents

The law n. 94/2009 (provisions relating to public safety), provides that for the issue of a residence permit for EC long-term resident alien must also demonstrate knowledge of the Italian language.

The minimum level of proficiency that is required to obtain a residence permit for EC long-term residents corresponds to level A2 of the Common European Framework of reference for knowledge of languages approved by the Council of Europe. The knowledge of the Italian language **level A2** can be demonstrated in various ways, in the absence of certification of knowledge

of Italian, therefore, to obtain a permit for EC long-term need to take a **test** in a CTP. To apply for participation in the test of knowledge of the Italian language must be logged on to the site <https://nullaostalavoro.interno.it/Ministero/index2.jsp> by registering and logging on to the “reserved area”. Registration is free, and necessarily require a valid e-mail address and running to be performed. For help in submitting your application, you can contact a **patronage**.

The test is also not necessary if the EU permit is required:

- for children under 14 years old;
- By persons suffering from serious limitations on the capacity for language learning, evidenced by certificate produced by a health care facility.

Knowledge of Italian and Integration Agreement

March 10, 2012 entered into force the regulation governing the **Integration Agreement**. From this date, the non-EU citizen who enter Italy for the first time and requires a permit of stay of not less than one year must **sign an agreement** with the Italian state. By signing this agreement, the foreign national is committed to achieving specific objectives of integration in the period of validity of his residence permit and the State is committed to supporting the process of integration of foreigners through the assumption of each initiative in a suitable fitting with regional and local authorities. In particular, as can be read in the text of the agreement, the foreign national becomes a series of commitments, including those to acquire a **knowledge of the Italian language spoken** at least equivalent to level A2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages issued by the Council of Europe. With the signing of the agreement, are assigned 16 **credits** initials. The confirmation of these loans are a result of the compulsory attendance of a free session of civic education and information about life in Italy, held at the **One-Stop Shops for immigration Prefectures**. On this occasion you will also receive information on “efforts to support the process of integration” (such as free courses in Italian) active in the province.

SOLVIT is a free service, operates from July 2002, and although its operation is the responsibility of Member States, the European Commission providing for the infrastructure and, if necessary, provide assistance to accelerate the solution of the problems. It shall also send a SOLVIT formal complaints it receives when there is a good chance that the problem can be resolved without the need for legal action.

EUROPEAN VOLUNTARY SERVICE

The European Voluntary Service (EVS) allows young people aged 18 to 30 to become a volunteer in another country for a period between 2 and 12 months. The service activities can be in the field of culture, activities with children, young people or the elderly, sports and leisure activities, environment and so on.

The Volunteers get board and lodging, travel, local transport, complete health insurance, linguistic training, and a small monthly pocket money covered by the hosting organization.

It's an international voluntary program financed by the European Commission within the **Erasmus+** program, with aim/purpose/objective of improving young people's competence and to promote solidarity, active citizenship and mutual understanding among youngsters.

The European Voluntary Service allows young people to do voluntary work in a foreign country, different from their native one, increasing solidarity among them and giving them the chance to learn new languages and new skills.

Who can help you get started

First you have to find a hosting organization in a European country and a sending organization in Italy. **Movimentazioni Association in Pescara is both a sending and a hosting organization that prepares you and sends you abroad.** To get in touch, you must send an email attaching an Europass CV and a motivation letter (in English).
